REPORT ON FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM STUDENTS 2019-20

The Feedback forms were distributed to the students in accordance with the notice issued by the IQAC Coordinator on 14-03-2020. Unfortunately, due to the advent of COVID-19 pandemic, and subsequent lockdown of all educational institutions from 24-03-2020, only 20 nos. of filled up forms were received till 23-03-2020. As there was no provision for collection of feedback forms on online mode at that time, so the analysis was restricted to those 20 nos. of received forms only. A simple percentile statistical study of the forms reveal the following information:

Remarks: From the result, it is evident that the students are highly satisfied with majority of the parameters of survey.
