REPORT ON FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM TEACHERS 2021-22

Teachers' feedback was collected from a total of 20 nos. of both full time and permanent teachers of both Arts & Commerce streams for the year 2021-22. The feedback, thus received, reveals the following:
