### REPORT OF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON TEACHERS FOR THE YEAR 2022-23

A total of 446 Feedback Forms were collected from all the students of Arts & Commerce stream. The Feedback Forms consists of 05 parameters on a point scale of 05. Very good and Good parameters were measured in terms of percentage of satisfaction; and Average, Poor and Very poor were measured in terms of percentage of dissatisfaction. A simple percentile statistical study of the Forms received reveals the following information:

# REPORT ON FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM STUDENTS ON OVERALL EVALUATION OF PROGRAMME AND TEACHING




