# Activities conducted by Different Cells

## Women's Cell

1) A Community Service and Survey among the women residents in Bethukandi village, was conducted by Women's Cell, RMC, Silchar on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2023 in collaboration with the NGO named 'PAAVAN'. About 60 marginalised females of the village were distributed clothes and health drinks by the cell while some essential food items were provided to them by the members of NGO 'PAAVAN'. The whole programme was carried out under the guidance of an active member (Pinak Roy) of the local NGO (Rising Youth Society).



2) International Women's Day was celebrated by the cell on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023 in the college premises this year which is usually celebrated on 8<sup>th</sup> March every year but this year due to the festival of HOLI, this celebration has been a little deferred. This year the International Women's Day was celebrated with a small cultural programme based on the theme "WOMEN". The programme also included a theme-based lecture given by Mrs. Aparjita Bhattacharjee who is the only renowned female priest and master of Vedic literature of Barak Valley. On that very day, certificates were distributed to all the female students who completed their three-month Taekwondo course by the female teaching members of the college.
