Please find enclosed a letter DO No. 5031/DO/D Dated 26th of April 2025, received from Brig. Rajeev Kumar, Dy. Director General, Recruiting (NE States), HQ Recruiting Zone (NE States), Shillong trying to draw attention towards recruitment of unmarried youth (within 17 ½ to 21 years) of the State of Assam to join in the Indian Armed Forces.

Brig. Kumar has informed that vacancies are likely to be doubled under the **Agnipath Scheme** from the recruiting year 2025-26 onwards. It has also been stated in his letter that the registration response from eligible candidates in the State has been significantly lower than expected.

As such, Brig. Kumar has requested support to intensify awareness campaign at the grass root level i.e, Schools, Colleges, ITIs and Gram Panchayats in conjunction with local Army Recruiting Offices at –Jorhat, Narangi, Silchar & Shillong. Besides, the involvement of ex-servicemen, awareness through State sponsored media programme with emphasis on utilization of social media campaign is also being stressed upon.

In view of the above, you are requested to issue necessary instructions to all concerned to take all possible measures to intensify awareness campaign for registration of eligible youth from the State for recruitment under Agnipath Scheme.

ENROLMENT OF YOUTH FOR AGNIPATH SCHEME
IN STATE OF ASSAM

Dear Hon'ble Chief Minister,

1. **Headquarter Recruiting Zone, (North East States)** located at Shillong is responsible for **recruitment of Agniveer** from all the seven States of North East. Army Recruiting Office at Jorhat, Narangi, Silchar and Shillong are responsible for recruitment of Agniveer from all districts of Assam, under the Agnipath Scheme of Government of India. Enrolment of the youth in the ibid scheme will not only enhance their chances of their own **career building** at a very young age but will also involve them in **nation building**. I take this opportunity to draw your kind attention towards enrolment of unmarried youth from **17 1/2 to 21 Years of State of Assam** to join Indian Armed Forces.
2. The Agnipath Recruitment in the Indian Army is an ambitious Government plan and endeavors are being made at all levels to ensure the **successful implementation of scheme**. While the State has had significant contribution to the Armed Forces, the participation of the youth for the scheme needs to be enhanced in the coming years. Low registration for the scheme may have a direct impact on the number of vacancies being allotted for the State and also may lead to surrender of vacancies due to non-availability of eligible youth for enrolment in the Army.
- 3 Furthermore, it is highlighted herein that the **vacancies are likely to be doubled under the Agnipath Scheme from Recruiting Year 2025-26 onwards** which will require registration by candidates to increase considerably to ensure utilization of vacancies. While Army has been spreading awareness through various programmes, the registration response from eligible candidates in the State has been significantly lower.

than expected. This may be attributed to factors such as lack of awareness or accessibility issues from remote areas of the State and likely misconceptions spread in the environment with respect to Agnipath Scheme. I am enclosing details of low registration districts in the State for your perusal as Appendix.

4. Apropos, may I earnestly request the support from your good office to direct the concerned authorities to intensify awareness campaign at the grassroot level i.e Schools, Colleges, ITIs and Gram Panchayats in conjunction with Army Recruiting Office, Jorhat, Narangi, Silchar & Shillong, including additional measures i.e involvement of ex-servicemen, awareness through State sponsored media programme with emphasis on utilization of social media campaign and appointment of State nodal officer to liaise with Army Recruiting Offices for exchange of information, assistance during conduct of rallies and bridging the gap between the two organisations to ensure maximum participation of eligible youth in the recruitment process in the coming years.
